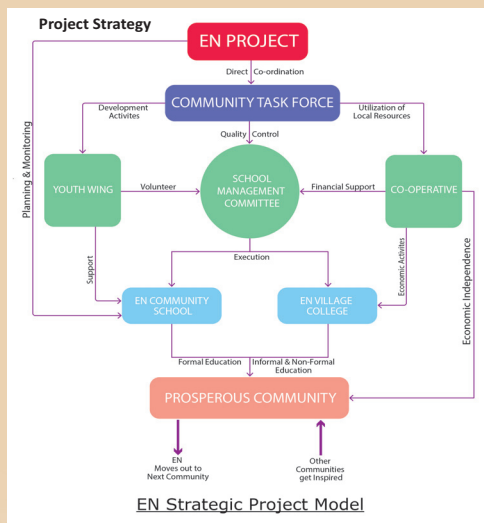


## Objective

- Promote and advocate for free and quality education in marginalized communities of Nepal (EFA)
- Empower women and dependent population of deprived communities
- Encourage and facilitate youth towards self-employment opportunities.
- Create a self sustainable spiral community model
- Use 4 Es (Education, Empowerment, Employment, and Ethics) for sustainable development of rural communities in Nepal.

## Project Majhi Gaun.

Majhi Gaun a village of fishermen as translated in English is an extremely deprived community consisting of 85 homogeneous households. The actual name of the village is Jholunge. It lies in Sindhupalchowk District which is 85Km North-east from the capital. This is the village where we have been implementing our project model.





## The Need

- Recovery from the devastating earthquake of April 25 that took lives of over 8,000 and has left around 800,000 people homeless.
- Promotion and encouragement of youth initiatives dedicated towards sustainable development
- Social awakening and social justice.
- Partnerships and collaborations for better future of Nepal

## Our work in Jholunge before Earthquake

- Community school by the name Suryodaya Primary School in operation, providing free quality education to over 130 students, nursery through grade 5 till date
- Toilets in every house. Open Defecation Free (ODF) village
- 31 member Community Task Force CTF (ama samuha) also referred as WOMEN (Wonderful Mothers Educating Nepal) taking the lead in developmental aspects of the community
- 5 mothers under training with sewing, stitching and embroidery skill. And 2 youths trained and had started a poultry farm from Jholunge village college
- A bigger scale Community Farm to generate revenue for the school was the investment plan of this year.





## The 4/25 Effect in Our Project

- Sindhupalchowk is amongst the most severely affected districts
- 100% of the houses completely destroyed. 8 people died, 25 critically injured
- Over 300 livestock buried under debris.
- Luckily one of school buildings remained intact and provided the whole community with shelter for whole month after the earthquake.

## Our work in Jholunge after the Earthquake; Changed priorities, unchanged beliefs.



### Immediate Relief-

We provided food, blankets, clothes, tents and crucial sanitation equipments to last enough for a month not just in Jholunge but in about 25 villages of severely affected districts.

Improved temporary shelters for 85 families were constructed

Cleared the debris of destroyed houses using bull dozer and prepared the terrain for planned permanent reconstruction.

Escalated more of entrepreneurial and income generating activities in the village to recover economic independence.



## Our Next Move

Help construct permanent shelters in the village in a well planned manner.

Increase vocational and business activities from Jholunge Village College, start a co-operative and pave path for economic independence of the people.

Self sustained community school and a prosperous community.

Make model village and move to another community with the same spiral concept.
